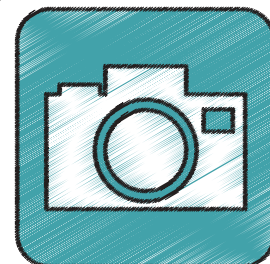

Corn Hole has a new time. Beginning December 1st, 2018 corn hole will start at 5:00PM

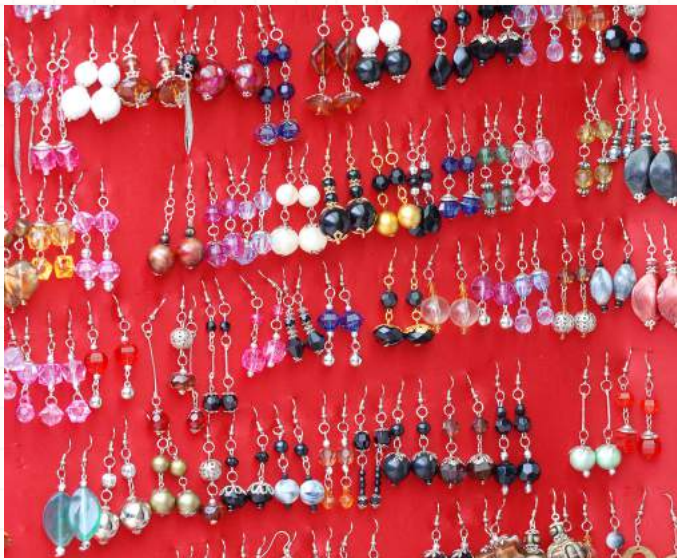
